Who was Mary Magdalene?


• Beautiful

Conversion

- She used her long hair to wipe Jesus' feet dry.
- She anointed them with expensive perfume.



A sinner touched Jesus?!

 - "Your faith has saved you. Go in peace."



Following Jesus

- Mary served Jesus and his apostles.
- She was at the foot of the cross with the Blessed Mother and John.

- Mary visited the tomb to anoint Jesus' body with spices on Easter Sunday.
- The tomb was empty!
- She cried outside the tomb.
- Jesus appeared in front of her! He had risen from the dead and chose to appear to Mary Magdalene FIRST!
- She was sent to announce the good news to the apostles.
